#### **Biographical and Historical Note**

Charles Goode Gomillion was born in Johnston, South Carolina. He was the first child born to Charles and Flora Gomillion on April 1, 1900. He attended the Public Schools of Edgefield County; received the A.B. Degree (Cum Laude) in 1928 from Paine College, Augusta, Ga., completed one year of graduate study in Sociology at Fisk University, Nashville, TN., and received the PhD. Degree in Sociology from The Ohio State University in 1959. His Honorary

Doctorates are from Howard University, The Ohio State University, and Tuskegee University. His civic and political affiliations are varied. In 1951, Gomillion was elected as president of the Paine College National Alumni Association, and as a member of the Paine College Board of Trustees. He served as teacher and Professor of Tuskegee Institute, Tuskegee, Alabama from 1928-1971.
