Paine College first Board of Trustees was organized on November 1, 1882. Bishop George F. Pierce, after consultation with the Bishops of the C.M.E Church, called a meeting of certain parties to be held in Augusta, Georgia on November 1, 1882 at St. Johns Church. Bishop Pierce reported that the following persons had been appointed as trustees from the M.E. Church, South: W. P. Patillo of Atlanta, Ga., W. B. Hill of Macon , Ga., W. A. Candler of Sparta, Ga., and Rev. J. E. Evans, D. D., had been appointed Educational Commissioner. Bishop L. H. Holsey of the C.M. E. Church reported the names of the following persons as trustees from their body: J. S. Harper of Augusta, Ga., R.A. Maxey of Barnesville, Ga., and L. H. Holsey of Augusta, Ga. On motion, James E. Evans was called to the chair and W. A. Candler requested to act as Secretary. (Excerpt from *Board of Trustees Minutes 1882*)
