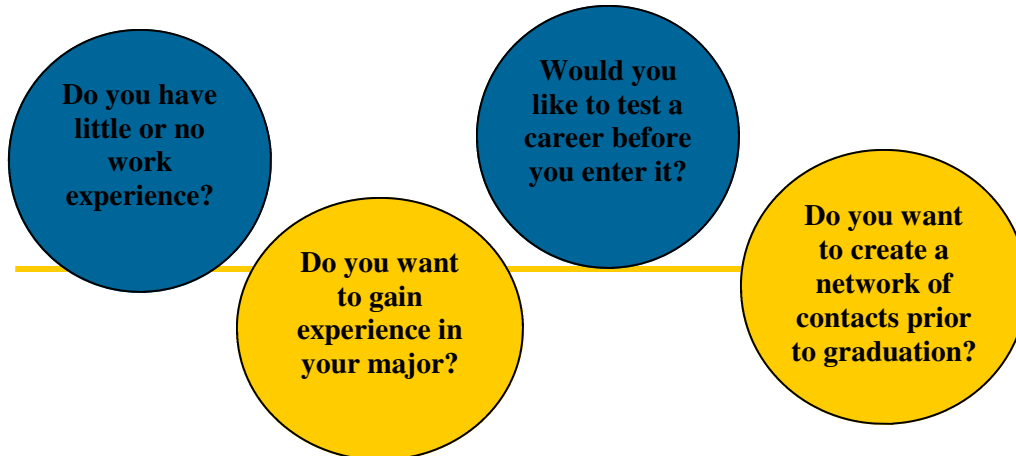


Interconnect with Internships
